**2nd HLMUN Concludes Successfully After 104 Days
of Preparation
-November 5 Event Held
at the International Conference Hall-**



On Tuesday, November 5, the second Hallym Model United Nations (HLMUN) officially concluded its 104-day journey with a general assembly held at the International Conference Hall of Hallym University. The event ran from 9:00 a.m. to approximately 5:00 p.m., bringing together student delegations from various departments.

The proceedings commenced with an opening speech by Professor Jeong-Hyun Ahn of the Department of Global Studies. This was followed by congratulatory and motivational video messages from National Assembly Member Heo Young and Visiting Professor Pyo Chang-won of Forensic Science and Criminology.

Han-Gil Lee, Chair of the 2nd Hallym Model UN Association, delivered the opening remarks, emphasizing the significance of the event. “This general assembly provides a vital platform for young voices in the international community,” he stated. “I hope HLMUN continues to grow and thrive in the years to come.”

The keynote session focused on the agenda, “Global Discussions on the Protection and Resettlement of Climate Refugees.” Delegates presented Resolution A, which centered on the “Definition of Climate Refugees,” followed by a dynamic Q&A session. Among the proposals, only the resolution introduced by the Bangladeshi delegation was adopted.

In the afternoon, the assembly deliberated on Resolution B, addressing “Economic and Technological Support Measures for Climate Refugees.” The debate, alternating between formal and informal sessions, was marked by intense discussions. However, no proposals under Resolution B secured approval.

The event concluded with an awards ceremony recognizing outstanding contributions. Certificates of merit,

signed by Hallym University President Yang-Hee Choi, were presented to exceptional delegations. The Grand Prize was awarded to the Bangladeshi delegation, represented by Jeong-Min Oh (Forensic Science, Class of 2021), Hyo-Jin Go, and Ga-Hyeon Yoon (both Global Business majors, Class of 2023). The Excellence Award was presented to the United States delegation, while Encouragement Awards were given to delegations from Saudi Arabia, Korea, and China.

With enthusiastic participation and meaningful dialogue, the 2nd Hallym Model United Nations concluded successfully, leaving a lasting impression on all attendees.
