HLMUN Delegates Hold Orientation, Taking the First Step with Agenda Selection Vote

- Agenda on Combating Illicit Drugs Adopted, Approaching the Issue from a Global Perspective -

The Orientation Session for the 3rd Hallym University Model United Nations (HLMUN) was held on 24 September at 7 p.m. in Room 1163, College of Engineering. During the session, delegates determined the direction of future meetings through the selection of the main agenda item and country assignments.

A total of ten delegations participated in the vote, choosing among three proposed agenda items. As a result, the votes were tallied as follows: ▲ International Cooperation for Building a Fair Global Supply Chain (2 votes) ▲ Establishing International Norms and Governance for Artificial Intelligence Technologies (3 votes) ▲ Enhancing Global Health through Support for Illicit Drug Production Regions and Supply Chain Disruption (5 votes). Consequently, “Enhancing Global Health through Support for Illicit Drug Production Regions and Supply Chain Disruption” was officially adopted as the agenda for the 3rd HLMUN.

The session also featured statements from delegates and members of the Secretariat, who shared their motivations and aspirations. Hong Hyuk-joo, delegate of Mexico, stated, “I first came across the Model United Nations through Instagram last year, and I was deeply impressed by how closely it mirrors the procedures of actual UN conferences. I decided to participate because I believed it would be a valuable opportunity to learn.” He added, “Through my participation as a delegate, I hope to develop the ability to analyze the global challenges faced by the international community and to strengthen my diplomatic communication skills in seeking cooperative solutions.”

Kim Ye-won, delegate of Myanmar, explained her country selection by saying, “Myanmar is a country that currently faces severe political instability and economic crisis, placing it at the center of global attention. Having previously participated in a project on emerging economies, I wanted to take part in deeper discussions surrounding poverty and the right to livelihood, which lie at the root of the illicit drug issue.” She continued, “Rather than focusing on blame, I wish to contribute to constructive dialogue that explores sustainable economic and diplomatic solutions.”

Kang Dong-hyun, Head of the Education Support Team, remarked, “It was meaningful to meet all participants for the first time through

today's orientation and to share our collective direction moving forward. Together with our assigned support members, we will ensure that all delegations are well-prepared for the agenda discussions." He added, "As team leader, I will take responsibility for providing balanced and consistent support so that every delegation can participate smoothly and complete the Model UN successfully."

The HLMUN will proceed with three informal consultations, culminating in the Formal General Assembly scheduled for 5 November, where delegates will deliberate and adopt draft resolutions on the selected agenda.
