The 3rd HLMUN Successfully Concludes Discussions on Combating Illegal Drugs
- A Field of Multilateral Dialogue and Negotiation Experience... China Delegation Takes the Grand Prize -

The 3rd Hallym University Model United Nations (HLMUN) was held on Wednesday, November 5, at Hallym University's International Conference Hall. This year's conference was held under the theme "Promoting Global Health through Supporting Illegal Drug Production Regions and Disrupting Supply Chains." Delegations from ten countries participated, presenting policy alternatives based on their respective national perspectives.

Opening the event, Secretary-General Song Gun-ho stated, “HLMUN is not merely a formal or symbolic event, but a process of thinking together about the complex issues of the international community,” expressing his hope that “today’s discussions will help shape meaningful directions for the future.”

Kim Dong-gyu, President of the Hallym Model United Nations Association, added, “This year’s agenda is not just a national issue but a major global health crisis faced by all humanity. I hope the delegates’ in-depth discussions will serve as an opportunity to learn the values of mutual respect and cooperation.”

The opening ceremony was attended by Yuk Dong-han, Mayor of Chuncheon, and Park Jun-sik, Vice President of Hallym University, along with Professors Jung Yong-nam, Kim Jae-han, and Eom Han-jin, who served as the chairs and judges of the 3rd HLMUN. Professor Pyo Chang-won from the Department of Forensic Science delivered his congratulatory remarks via a video message.

Vice President Park expressed his hopes that “through this conference, students will broaden their perspectives on the world and learn the importance of cooperation and coordination.”

The General Assembly began with keynote speeches from each delegation. The representatives discussed the economic and social impacts of illegal drugs from their national standpoints and proposed ways for the international community to respond responsibly. During the official sessions that followed, various

resolutions were actively debated, focusing on production-site assistance, supply chain disruption, and multilateral cooperation as key strategies to address the issue.

At the award ceremony, the following delegations were honored:

Grand Prize: China

Excellence Award: Netherlands

Outstanding Awards: Australia, Myanmar

Encouragement Awards: Colombia, India

Jin Da-jung, delegate of China (Department of Law, Class of 2023), who won the Grand Prize, shared her reflections:

“In our committee’s resolution, the policy targets were not clearly specified, so I initially thought it would apply to the entire population. However, it turned out during the General Assembly that it only applied to specific groups, which was disappointing. I still remember not being able to ask further questions about it.”

She continued, “I participated because I aspire to work in an international organization, and it was meaningful to experience how the UN General Assembly operates firsthand. I used to think politics and diplomacy weren’t my areas of interest, but through this experience, I discovered a new side of myself.”

She also added, “The Secretariat’s dedication throughout the conference was truly impressive. I hope future participants will remember and appreciate their efforts.”

The 3rd HLMUN was the result of about six months of preparation since June, including a delegate orientation in September and four rounds of informal meetings that helped refine high-quality resolutions. Concluding successfully with the award ceremony, this year's conference offered students a valuable opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of global issues, experience the processes of negotiation and persuasion firsthand, and learn the importance of international cooperation.
